Two possible ways a party can join are compulsory or premissively. A compulsory joinder is one which intends to result in a just adjudication for the missing party which prevents injustice from resulting. A permissive joinder is one that occurs from the same T/O as the original complaint and can be added to decrease multiple litigation. The distill warehouse can join the suit under compulsory joinder in order to protect their interests and obtain adequate relief and representation in the present lawsuit. Joining the lawsuit would provide the warehouse to protect their interests and present their company.
